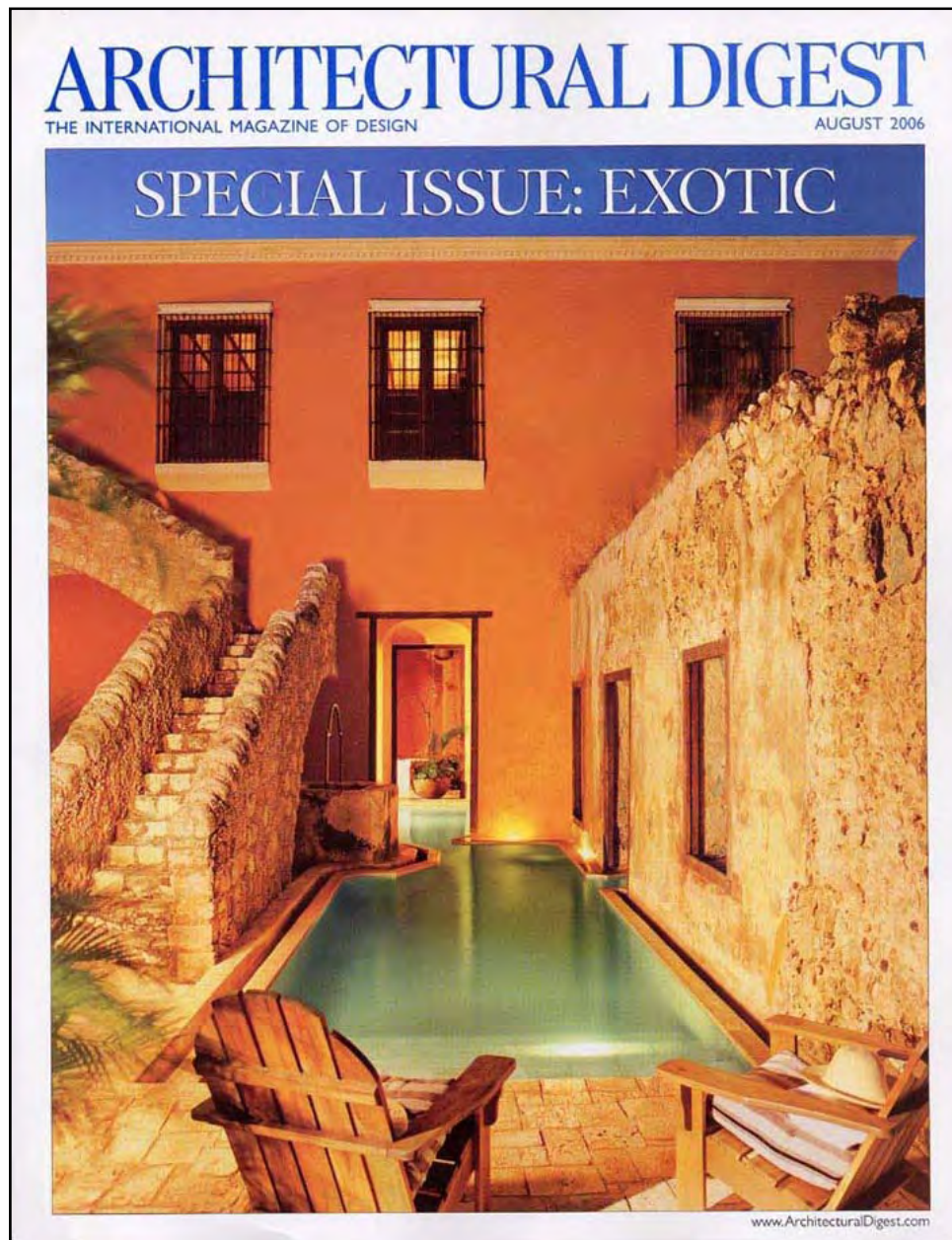

Center stage in a Balinese compound is a blue-tiled swimming pool that links together three pavilions (right). Built by Glenn Parker Architects, the pavilions feature teak-framed doors that fold back fully to create an open-air effect.
